### Back to Dance Night!

### 23.24 Registration and Tuition

Registration fee and costume deposits are paid at time of registration.

- Registration Fee is \$40 per family through August 1st, and \$45 per family starting on August 2nd
- Dance Concert costume deposit is \$35 per dancer, per costume (one costume deposit per class added)

Registration fees are non-refundable. If a concert class is dropped after November 15th, costume deposit will not be refunded. Your first monthly tuition payment will be charged on September 1st.

Nebraska Dance calendar is based on 35 weeks of scheduled classes and an end of year dance concert in early June. The cost for a class is an annual price, but for the convenience of our families, it is broken down and spread out over nine (9) monthly installments (September-May). The first installment will be charged to your account on September 1, 2023 and the final installment will be charged on May 1, 2024. \* If the 1st of the month falls on a weekend, tuition will be charged on the first business day of that month.

#### 2023.24 ND Class Tuition Rates (New for 23.24 this rate includes the dance concert fee)::

| Hours Per Week            | Tuition         |
|---------------------------|-----------------|
| 1 Class- 45 min           | \$65 per month  |
| 2 Classes- 1 hour 30 min  | \$105 per month |
| 3 Classes- 2 hours 15 min | \$135 per month |
| 4 Classes- 3 hours        | \$165 per month |

\*90 minute classes count as two 45 minute classes on the above tuition rate scale.

\*For tuition rates for more hours per week than listed above please email khayden@nebraskadance.com

\*Additional students in the same immediate family receive a 10% discount. The student with the highest number of classes is counted as student one.

### 2023.24 Nebraska Dance Age Level Tracks

**Peanut:** 18 months-2 year old\*

**Track B:** 4th-5th Grade

**Tiny:** 3 to 4 years old\*

**Track C:** 6th-8th Grade

**Mini:** 5 years to 1st Grade\*

**Track D:** 9th-12th Grade

**Track A:** 2nd-3rd Grade

*\*For peanut, tiny and mini classes, dancers must reach the minimum age for class by October 1st in order to register for classes in that age group for the 23.24 dance year. Dancers who miss the age cut-off may take classes in age track for their current age at the start of the season.*

### Adding/Dropping Classes

To make changes to your schedule, you must fill out the online "Change/Cancellation Form". Please email [info@nebraskadance.com](mailto:info@nebraskadance.com), visit our website, or see the front desk to have this form sent to you.

**THIS FORM MUST BE TURNED IN ONLINE BY THE 15TH OF THE MONTH IN ORDER TO CANCEL THE FOLLOWING MONTH'S TUITION.**

*\*Example - Must be turned in by October 15th to cancel November tuition. If the form is not turned in by the 15th of the month, your account will be charged for the following month's tuition.*

**November 15th** is the last day to add a class and still participate in the dance concert piece for that class, and also the last day to drop a class as not be charged the dance concert fee for that class.

### Costume Payments

Dance concert ticketing has moved to online ticketing with reserved seating! This prevents the need for waiting in line and allows families to choose their seats ahead of time. Tickets will be purchased through the online ticketing system. Tickets will range from \$14 to \$20 per show depending on the location of the seat.

The Costume Balance will be due **November 16th**. We will email information regarding this payment, which will be charged to your payment method on file in your account by the 16th of November. The remaining balance (less costume deposits paid at time of registration) is due November 16th. You will receive an email indicating the balance due for all costumes prior to the balance being charged to your payment method on file.

Costume Fees will be charged automatically to your payment method on file. We highly recommend that all students participate in the dance concerts the weekend of May 30th-June 2nd, 2024. If for any reason your student is not able to participate in the dance concert, please complete the form that will be sent out to all families prior to Nov 15th to avoid being charged for the costume balance. You will be asked to fill out a form confirming and documenting your non-participation.

If the payment of the costume balance is not paid by November 16th, **COSTUME(S) WILL NOT BE ORDERED FOR YOUR STUDENT**. If costume(s) are not ordered, they will be unable to participate in the dance concert or pictures. When you do pay for a costume deposit at registration, you understand that you are obligated to purchase the costume and pay the remaining balance in November for each class that your student is dancing in the dance concert, unless a class cancellation form has been completed by November 16th. Please note that costume fee(s) are non-refundable.

Costumes are distributed and/or available for pickup at the studio approximately 1-2 weeks prior to Picture week in the spring.

### Personal Belongings

Please label everything you bring to dance! We do have a lost and found. Please make sure you check it for lost items. **Nebraska Dance is NOT RESPONSIBLE for lost or damaged personal items for either parents, students, or relatives/friends.** Please DO NOT bring valuables to the studio.

### Make Up Classes

If your student has to miss a class, they are welcome to schedule a make-up in another class in their track at or below their level. The class needs to be made up within ONE MONTH of the missed class. **Please schedule your make-up class in advance by emailing [skoenig@nebraskadance.com](mailto:skoenig@nebraskadance.com).**

### Snow/Cold Days

We generally follow the local PUBLIC SCHOOLS CLOSING to make a decision on our classes to be canceled for class that day. However, if the weather seems to be clearing up throughout the day, we will make a decision by 2:00pm. If school is in session and the weather conditions become poor throughout the day, we will make a decision by 2:00pm. Families registered for classes will be emailed a message in the case of cancellation and we also post on social media. We will most likely NOT cancel if the school districts close for 'cold days'. If we choose to have our classes and you feel it is too dangerous to drive, we support that decision. We do not credit, refund or prorate tuition for classes canceled due to inclement weather. The first time a particular day of the week has a snow day, you are welcome to schedule make-up if you choose. If that same day of the week has more than one snow day, we will offer a make-up class date over spring break.

### Positive Environment

At Nebraska Dance, we work hard to create a positive, healthy environment for our students and we need your help! Please keep a positive attitude when in the studio. Your attitude affects everyone else around you! If you have a concern, please feel free to make an appointment with a Director.

### Pets

Pets or animals are not allowed in the buildings, this includes lobby and vestibule areas.

We will plan to hold our annual dance concerts May 30th-June 2nd, 2024

Dress rehearsals will be planned for May 28th-30th, 2024. Exact dates and times for each show, dress rehearsal group, as well as the venue for the dance concert are TBA.

Mini Show 5 (all Friday & Saturday Peanut, Tiny, Mini Classes)  
Track C/D Dance Concert (all Track C & D, 6th-12th Grade classes)  
Track A Dance Concert (all Track A, 2nd-3rd Grade classes)  
Track B Dance Concert (all Track B, 4th-5th Grade classes)

**Important Dance Concert Note-** Please carefully review the dance concert shows above. When you select your classes, you are also selecting which concert your student(s) will perform in. Track A, B, C/D classes are all in the concert for their age group regardless of the day of the week classes are held. Peanut, Tiny and Mini Classes are assigned to a different show depending on the class day of the week. Please be aware that tickets are required for each dance concert show you attend, and ticket prices range from \$14-\$20 each. There is also a livestream option for those who cannot attend in person. NEW THIS YEAR, the Dance Concert fee will be a part of monthly tuition. This fee covers the tshirt provided for your student to wear at the Dance Concert finale as well as show production expenses.
